January 16th, 2023, we celebrate Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. Each year Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday (January 15, 1929) is celebrated on the third Monday in January. This day honors the life of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and his fight for racial justice and equality for every nationality. He dedicated his life to a nonviolent approach to civil rights. Dr. King's leadership was essential in ending engrained segregation and the creation of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. This day is also known as a National Day of Service. Each year many Americans step up to make communities more equitable and take action to create the community of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s dream. Americans are encouraged to volunteer to improve their own community. AmeriCorps created a <u>volunteer search</u> for individuals to help find local organizations that need assistance.

On Monday, The University of Pennsylvania's Society of Women Engineers (SWE) will be hosting **GEARS Day**. GEARS Day is a day-long, no-cost camp intended to educate high school girls about engineering professions. The event is on Penn's campus. Attendees will participate in hands-on workshops focusing on various engineering disciplines including bioengineering, chemical engineering, electrical engineering, mechanical engineering, and computer science. Participants will also get a chance to hear from and speak with engineering professors and college students. The program seeks to inspire attendees and show them that women can enter such fields with vast opportunities available to them.

Four of the students qualify for the State Leadership Conference which will be held in April.
