TIMELINE

- SEPTEMBER TO JANUARY: COMPLETE APPLICATIONS – KNOW THE DEADLINES (NOV 1 IS IDEAL)
- OCTOBER: PARENTS COMPLETE FINANCIAL AID FORMS – FAFSA, CSS PROFILE (PRIVATE SECTOR), AND IN SOME CASE INSTITUTIONAL FORMS
- NOVEMBER TO FEBRUARY/MARCH – ACCEPTANCE LETTERS ROLL IN
- FEBRUARY AND MARCH – FINANCIAL AID PACKAGE LETTERS ARRIVE – COMPARE PACKAGES AND DON'T BE AFRAID TO NEGOTIATE
- APRIL – DECISION TIME
- MAY 1 – UNIVERSAL DEADLINE – SEND THE DEPOSIT


- MNHS DOES NOT SEND SCORES FOR YOUR CHILD

- MOST COLLEGES THIS YEAR ARE TEST OPTIONAL



- FERPA WAIVER IN COMMON APP
- IN ORDER FOR YOUR CCAC TO SEND LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION – YOU MUST COMPLETE THE FERPA WAIVER IN COMMON APP
- YOU MUST WAIVE YOUR RIGHT TO VIEW LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

SRAR AND SELF-REPORT COLLEGES

- PENN STATE REQUIRES AN ADDITIONAL STEP BEFORE THEY WILL REVIEW THE APP – SRAR (SELF-REPORT ACADEMIC RECORD)
- PENN STATE FIRST REVIEW IS EARLY OCTOBER THIS YEAR
- UPITT, UDE, VATECH, NYU, UTENN, CLEMSON, UF & PSU ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF SELF-REPORT

TERMS & FACTS CON'T

- COLLEGES WILL MAKE UP DIFFERENCE BY COMBINING LOANS, GRANTS, SCHOLARSHIPS AND WORK-STUDY
- FINANCIAL AID OFFICERS – SHARE ANY UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES WITH A POTENTIAL COLLEGE (SUCH AS A DEATH, DIVORCE, MEDICAL EXPENSES, LOSS OF INCOME, ETC.)
- SCHOLARSHIPS: MONEY THAT YOU DO NOT NEED TO PAY BACK AND USUALLY IS TIED TO SOME KIND OF TALENT, ORGANIZATION, ATHLETICS, ACADEMICS, CLUB, RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS, ROTARY, ETC.
- GRANTS: MONEY THAT YOU DON'T NEED TO PAY BACK THAT IS USUALLY DETERMINED BY NEED – COMES FROM THE GOVERNMENT OR THE UNIVERSITY
- LOANS: MONEY THAT NEEDS TO BE PAID BACK AND IS PART OF MOST STUDENT AID PACKAGES
- WORK-STUDY: FOURTH KIND OF FINANCIAL AID – USUALLY INVOLVES A PART-TIME JOB WHILE YOU ARE IN COLLEGE
- NCAA: STUDENTS CONSIDERING COLLEGIATE ATHLETICS (DIV I OR II) – NCAA CLEARINGHOUSE: [HTTPS://WEB3.NCAA.ORG/ECWR3/](https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/)



Gettysburg recognizes students' academic achievement in high school by awarding five categories of scholarships.

Decisions on the scholarship recipients are made as part of the [admissions process](#) for entering first-year students. The four academic merit scholarships (Lincoln, Presidential, David Wills, and Founders) are awarded under Early Decision and Regular Decision as part of the admissions review process; a separate application is not required.

The [Eisenhower Scholarship](#), designed to recognize students' commitment to civic engagement, requires a [separate application](#).

The selection process for these scholarships is highly competitive with awards going to **top-ranking applicants** based
