To all MNHS Families,

This week is the last week of in-person schooling for our seniors. We wish you well during your senior projects. Tuesday May 18th, is an in-service day and there is no school for students. May 19th is our Keystone literature-testing day. Only students taking the Keystone Literature exam will be in person on this day. All other students will have asynchronous work to complete.

We would like to remind everyone that your student's grades are posted on both Schoology and Infinite campus, which can be easily accessed at any time. Reviewing your student's grades and progress weekly will greatly improve their level of success. Please reach out to your student's teachers when you have questions regarding grades and progress.

Health Screening and students in virtual learning: The School District provides health screening for every student (height, weight, vision, and hearing). The school nurse completes the health screening according to Pennsylvania regulations. If your child is currently learning through our virtual program and you would like to have the School District conduct a health screening for your child, please contact the school nurse June Cloran at 610-359-4221 to make an appointment during the school day. In lieu of health screening, you may send a copy of your child's most recent physical if the physical was conducted during this school year.

Reminder from the Nurse: To keep our MNHS community safe please complete the daily Covid-19 Screening form for each child before sending your child to school. If you answer **YES** to any of the questions, please keep your child home from school and contact the school nurse June Cloran at 610-359-4221 or email at jcloran@mnsd.org.

- Students **entering 12th grade in the Fall of 2021 require** documentation from their health care provider that they received a **2nd dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV) by the first day of school.**
- Your child can receive the 2nd dose of the vaccine any time after age 16.
